“Look at Us”

1) Look at Us - vs 4

- Discuss why you think Peter may have said the above to the lame beggar?
- In what ways can we/others look to the wrong places for our needs?
- Discuss what you think people’s deepest need is?

Before Jesus ascended he was able to say “Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father” John 14:9

NOW the Father is looking to us his church, his bride to display and shine the likeness of the living God by us partnering with the presence of the Holy Spirit

- How can we represent, shine, reveal the family likeness here on earth?

2) What do I have? – vs 6 or “what I do have”

Luke 12:32 Jesus promises his followers “Fear not, little flock, for it is your Fathers good pleasure to give you the Kingdom”

- What does it mean for us to have the Kingdom - or what do you have in Christ?

3) I give to you – vs 6

Matt 10:7-8 (NIV) “As you go, proclaim this message: ‘the kingdom of heaven has come near.’ Heal those who are ill, raise the dead, cleanse those who have leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you have received; freely give”

- In Mark 4 it talks about how the Kingdom of God looks like men and women planting seeds, liberally giving away the good news of the Kingdom. How are we to do this?
- When we say “Let your Kingdom come” we bring the authority of the King and speak it into being... healing, deliverance and resurrection life to people; establishing the reign of King Jesus here on earth – Pray for situations where Gods rule needs to come.
